- Photo of the candidate to be submitted: The following points must be ensured regarding the photo:
- (i) Photo should be in full colour and of high quality to avoid any visible pixels.
- (ii) Photo must be taken in the last 6 months.
- (iii) Head should be positioned directly facing camera, centered and compose 80% of image. Photo should capture from slightly above top of hair to middle of chest.
- (iv) Have a natural expression smiling is allowed.
- Subject (candidate) is in clear focus and distinguishable from the background. Solid colour backgrounds are best.
- (vi) Eyes must be open and looking at the camera. Glasses must not be tinted unless worn daily for medical purposes.
- (vii) The individual's full face must be clearly visible.
- (viii) The name and date of the photograph to be clearly mentioned below the photo.
- 3. Two photographs to be submitted, one affixed to the registration form, which will be given to the candidate in class and the other photograph to be submitted separately to the class teacher.
- 4. All the students enrolled in the school shall have to complete the attendance requirement.

Subject: Climate Science Olympiad 2022

Dear Students & Parents,

Greetings of the day!

Climate Science Olympiad is inviting students to participate in the Climate Science Olympiad 2022

It is a free and online competition for students aiming to educate them about various issues related to the climate crisis and empower them to be future climate leaders.

## > The competition will have four rounds:

- Round 1 (Qualifiers): The qualifier round is a 25-minute online quiz in the form of Multiple-Choice questions.
- Round 2 (Quarter Finals): The best 10% of all qualifier attempts advance to the Quarter Finals. Quarter Finals follow the same quick-question format as Qualifiers.
- Round 3 (Semi Finals): In the Semi-Final, participants choose one of three problem statements to respond to. To help them prepare, topics are told 10 days before the event, but the exact problem statement is only revealed at the start of the actual qualifier event. Then participants have 3 hours to research and write essay responses to questions related to the problem statement. Climate Science will score each team's solution.
- Round 4 (The Final): Every finalist will be awarded a Bronze Medal, the top 20 and top 10 will be awarded a Silver and Gold Medal, respectively. The top teams split the prize pool of \$15,000 (USD).
  In the finals, participants will write a proposal about a major climate-related issue and be interviewed by our judges.

- Climate Science Olympiad has different age brackets:
  - a) Students aged between 12 to 16 years
  - b) Students aged between 17 to 20 years
- Students can participate solo or in a team of two.
