✓ **School reopening details:**

✓ **Life skills:**

- ❖ The school sets an intense emphasis on cleanliness, and housekeeping personnel hired for the job regularly dusts and cleans the classrooms. ✓ **Advice for students for summer vacation:-**

- ❖ Every day, begin with a prayer. Wish your elders, read the newspaper daily.
- ❖ Every morning after waking up, make your bed. Assist your parents with home tasks including putting books and toys back where they belong after use, helping your mother set the table, serving guests, and shining your shoes.
- ❖ Helping mother to fold clothes and arrange them neatly on shelves. Learn simple recipes like vegetable sandwich, fruit salad, bhelpuri chat, milk shakes etc, under your parents' guidance.
- ❖ Learn table manners. Eat healthy food and drink lots of water.
- ❖ Play outdoor games but don't play during day time to avoid sunstroke.
- ❖ Say No to junk food. Don't litter and maintain your personal hygiene also.

- ❖ Together, explore new locations both inside and outside of the city limits while adhering to safety precautions and COVID standards. Encourage your child to keep a daily
- ❖ To help the youngster realise the contributions that their grandparents/ great grandparents made to the growth of their families/ societies, tell bedtime stories about their grandparents.
- ❖ Speak Golden words like ' Sorry, Please and Thank you' with your children quite often.
- ❖ With a view to keep your child actively engaged for some time every day, teachers have created fun filled assignments. Please guide your child to maintain regularity in completing them and enjoy them while doing it.
- ❖ Spend some time with your youngster playing indoor or outdoor games by taking time out of your busy routine.
- ❖ Note: The best method to teach our children the crucial life skills they need is to **spend quality time** together as a happy and healthy family. We all want to see children develop into mature, compassionate people who appreciate time.
